

Bennington Hall Trust Fund

What is it?

Following the sale of Bennington Hall in 1968, the Bennington Hall Trust Fund (BHTF) was set up and is now a registered charity (No. 262688). It is administered by a group of Trustees drawn from local Churches.

What does it do?

This is summed up in the principles of the scheme:

‘The net income of the Fund is to be used for the improvement of Christian education given to children and young people in Churches, Missions, Sunday Schools or Junior Churches in Cheltenham and District, and also in the wider work of Christian Education as the Trustees deem appropriate.’

How do I apply to the Fund?

The Trustees meet in April and October to consider awarding grants from the small income of the Fund.

If you believe you could benefit from the Fund please write to the Trustees, attaching our Application Form to the letter.

All Application Forms must be received by 25 March or 25 September. Applications will not be accepted retrospectively.

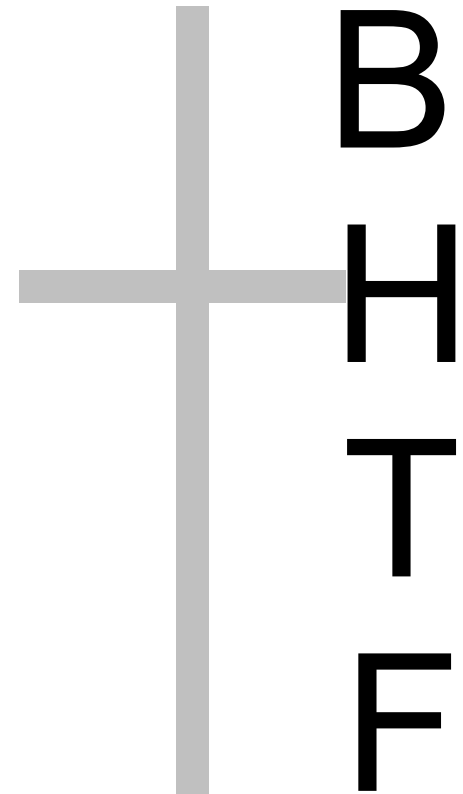
